

# Plain City Recreation Information

*\*All information is subject to change without prior notification. All changes will be posted as changes are made in a timely manner. This is a basic guideline and changes will be made as needed.*



## Baseball/Softball/Tee Ball-

Signups are during the month of March with the regular season starting in May and running through the end of June. Cost per player is \$35.00 - \$40.00, which includes a team shirt. See the following categories for the breakdown.

### *Preschool-Kindergarten:*

This program is for boys and girls who will be turning 4 before July 1<sup>st</sup> - Kindergarten. Signups are during the month of March and the season starts the 1<sup>st</sup> week of May running through the end of May, possibly the first week of June. Cost is \$35.00 per player, which includes a team shirt. Games are played either on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday.

This is the 1<sup>st</sup> level of our developmental league. We encourage everyone to remember that the purpose of this league is to teach the kids the basic fundamentals of throwing, catching and batting. The purpose of this league is for the kids to have a fun and positive experience.

**Rules are as follows:** All players will bat. Once your team has batted through the lineup you will switch places in the field. There are no outs, last batter will run all of the bases. No new inning will start after 45 minutes. There will be a youth official at all games and they will be in charge of running the game.

### *1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Coach Pitch:*

This program is for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade boys and girls. Signups are during the month of March and the season starts the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of May running to the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> week of June. Cost is \$35.00 per player, which includes a team shirt. Games are played either on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday.

This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> level of our developmental league and we start to introduce more of the fundamentals of baseball/softball.

**Rules are as follows:** Games are 55 minutes with no new inning starting after 50 minutes. Each player will be allowed a total of 6 pitches to hit the ball. If after 6 pitches, the batter has not hit the ball, he/she is out and will return to the bench. Each team will bat through the lineup and then switch places in the field. If a player is played on and is thrown or tagged out, they will return to the bench. If the kids are really upset about being out, we will let them stay on the base. We do not want to traumatize

anyone, but we want to encourage them to understand that this is the way the game is played. There will be a youth official at all games and they will be in charge of running the game.

### *3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Machine Pitch:*

This program is for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade boys and girls. Signups are during the month of March and the season starts the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of May running to the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> week of June. Cost is \$40.00 per player, which includes a team shirt. Games are played either on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday.

**Standard Baseball/Softball rules will be used with the exception of the following:** You bat through the lineup or 3 outs, whichever occurs first. The batter will receive a total of 5 pitches. 3 swung at strikes and the batter is out. After 5 pitches, if the batter has not hit the ball, he/she will be called out and will return to the bench. There will be no stealing and the only way you can advance from 3<sup>rd</sup> base is to be hit in. (*Extra pitches may be given at the discretion of the umpire*). There will be 1 or 2 youth official at all games and they will be in charge of running the game.

### *Baseball/Softball:*

This program is for grades 4<sup>th</sup>- 9<sup>th</sup>, girls playing Softball and boys playing Baseball. Signups are during the month of March and the season starts the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of May running to the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> week of June. Cost is \$40.00 per player, which includes a team shirt. Games are played either on Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday. **We follow the rules and guidelines set by Weber County Recreation.** (*See Weber County Recreation Rules*). All legal teams are eligible to participate in the Weber County Playoffs according to their standings at the end of the regular season. There will be 2 youth or adult umpires and a scorekeeper at all games. When deemed necessary there will be 3 umpires and a scorekeeper.



### Football-

Signups are during the month of July, generally during the first week. The regular season starts the first week of August (*sometimes including a few days in July*) and running through the end of October, including the playoffs and Minibowl. Cost per player is \$95.00 and jerseys are \$28.00 if needed. When signing up you need to bring a copy of the following: Proof of residency (utility bill), Birth certificate, current physical and proof of insurance. We run a football camp during the month of July, usually the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> week, and signups for this are during the regular football signup time period. The cost of this camp is \$40.00 which includes a camp t- shirt.

The football program is in affiliation with the WFFL (see website @ wffl.com for the bylaws and other information). The fees collected go towards the WFFL for an

annual association fee- \$55 per team, coaches badges, and home team associations are responsible for paying game officials for both regular and post-season play @ \$35.00 per official, per game, with 3 officials at each game. Fees also go towards the purchase of new equipment, repair costs, jerseys, mouth guards, footballs, coach's bags, coach's shirts, first aide kits, skill builder equipment, pants and pads, ect. Also on game day we are required to have a weight master, score and time keeper and a chain crew. Estimated actual cost to suit up individual players is \$175.00.



## Basketball-

Signups are during the month of September for girls. Cost per player is \$40.00 which includes a jersey which is turned in at the end of the season. Signups are during the month of November for boys. Cost per player is \$40.00 which includes a jersey which is turned in at the end of the season. Basketball season starts in October and runs through March. See the following categories for the breakdown.

### *2<sup>nd</sup> Grade girls:*

This program is for 2<sup>nd</sup> grade girls. Signups are during the month of September and the season starts at the end of October running through about the 2<sup>nd</sup> week in December. Cost is \$40.00 per player, which includes a jersey which is turned in at the end of the season. Games are played on Saturdays. Cost is \$40.00 per player, which includes a jersey which is turned in at the end of the season.
